

Hampton Elementary School's Reopening Information

Doors open at 9:00, instruction begins at 9:15, and students are dismissed at 3:45.

From March 1- 12, doors open at 9:00, instruction begins at 9:15, and students are dismissed at 1:45.

At Hampton we are committed to the safety of all students in school or at home. Our goal is to work closely with students and parents to achieve academic excellence and happy, productive citizens.

<p>Arrival & Dismissal Procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The car loop is only available in the morning. Students should exit cars without an adult getting out of the car.• Students follow the dolphins to the front door.• All walkers enter the building by the fields.• Walkers exit through the door near the fields.• Kindergarten students who are walkers are signed out on the ramp near the walker door.• Bus riders will exit each bus one at a time and enter through the front doors.• At the end of the day bus riders will load one at a time through the front doors.• Three-year olds and prekindergartners will enter through the front door or walker door.• Three-year olds and prekindergartners will be dismissed at the front door in the middle of the day.• Afternoon prekindergartners will enter through the front door and exit through the front door for bus riders and through the walker door near the fields.	<p>Face Covering:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Face coverings are required for all persons in a BCPS facility or vehicle as well as on BCPS property. Face coverings are required during transportation to/from school on a bus as well as outdoors on campuses.• Each school, office, and school bus will have a supply of disposable face coverings for students and employees who forget their face covering or whose face covering becomes soiled or damaged.
<p>Screening & Stay Home When Appropriate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All employees and students are expected to screen themselves daily for symptoms of COVID-19.• Remain home if you have symptoms, confirmed COVID-19 illness, had recent contact with a person with COVID-19 and/or awaiting test results.• Parents will receive a screening checklist and magnet with the screening practices.	<p>Social Distancing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Classroom furniture is arranged to provide 6-foot separation between students, when possible.• Reduce gathering of students in any area – refer to changes in arrival and dismissal procedures and movement in the hallways.
<p>Hand Hygiene:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Times for handwashing or use of hand sanitizer to include before and after meals, upon arrival to schools' offices and home, before and after use of any shared items, after use of the restroom, after sneezing/coughing and other time hands are contaminated.	<p>Breakfast & Lunch:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• All students are eligible for a free bagged breakfast as they enter the school and will eat breakfast in their classroom.• Students will each lunch in the cafeteria by grade level. Lunches are free to everyone. Students will walk through the line and pick up a hot bagged

	<p>lunch or yogurt box. They will sit at the designated smiley face seats.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students who bring their lunches will not be able to buy snacks or drinks.
<p>Supplies & Devices:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All students should bring a BCPS issued device and charger. All devices should be charged when they come to school. • Devices will come home with students each night • Headphones will be provided by school. • Classroom teachers will contact parents if additional supplies are needed. 	<p>Visitors:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To visit a BCPS school, visitors must have an appointment. • Visits will be conducted remotely or outside, whenever possible. • If an indoor visit is required, visitors will be required to wear a face coverings and practice social distancing. • The number of people admitted to the building will be limited.
<p>Social Emotional Support:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hampton Elementary has two full time school counselors, Ms. Dyer and Ms. Lepley. • Counseling supports are available for all students virtually or in person. • The counselors regularly teach classroom lessons to cover a variety of social emotional topics. • For 3's Pre-K, K, 2, 4, contact Ms. Lepley clepley@bcps.org • For 3's Pre-K, 1, 3, 5, contact Ms. Dyer mdyer@bcps.org 	<p>Before and After School Care:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • HotSpots Extended Care Program (HSECP) is accepting enrollments for hybrid before and after care at our Hampton Elementary School Program. • We have space available for students attending in-person learning for Cohorts A & B. • We are also offering teacher discounts. • Available spaces will fill quickly, so please visit hsecp.org or call (410) 329-8378 to enroll. • Please note, Enrollment for the 2021-22 school year will begin March 15th.
